SPOKANE VALLEY CITY COUNCIL TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2024 | MEETING RECAP

This week's Spokane Valley City Council meeting began with the pledge of allegiance and approval of the following meeting agenda. Mayor Haley and Deputy Mayor Hattenburg were absent due to attending a transit conference. Councilmember Higgins served as acting Mayor.

Proclamation

Councilmember Padden presented a proclamation for Fire Prevention Week received by Spokane Valley Fire Department Deputy Fire Marshall Ken Johnson, and Acting Mayor Higgins presented a proclamation for Cybersecurity Awareness Month received by City of Spokane Valley Information Technology Manager Chad Knodel.

General Public Comments

Each week, community members have an opportunity to address Councilmembers for up to three minutes during the General Public Comment period, either at the beginning or end of each meeting in person or via Zoom.

ACTION ITEMS

#1 2025 State Legislative Agenda

Council reviewed the draft legislative agenda at the Sept. 17 meeting. Staff reviewed the changes made per direction from the Council. The draft agenda for the 2025 state legislative session includes:

- \$800,000 request for construction of sports courts at Balfour Park
- \$1 million for Barker/I-90 interchange improvements
- Support for funding the Recreation and Conservation Office's grant programs for the Balfour Park playground and spray park
- Request for clarification regarding the administrative fees collected on document recording fee revenues
- Request to increase the percentage of cannabis tax revenues to cities

The agenda also includes outlining support for several regional items of importance and policy issues. A motion was made to approve the proposed 2025 State Legislative Agenda. The motion passed unanimously.

#2 Washington Department of Commerce Connecting Housing to Infrastructure Program (CHIP) Grant Opportunity

This item was discussed at the Sept. 24 meeting. This grant pays for the upfront costs of connecting and installing utility infrastructure to encourage the development of affordable housing projects. Spokane Housing Authority (SHA) will partner with the City on this project; Spokane Valley will be the primary applicant and if awarded, funding will be provided as a passthrough grant for the proposed Appleway Development housing project. A motion was made to authorize the city manager to apply for the CHIP grant in partnership with SHA. The motion passed with four votes in favor and one vote against. NON-ACTION ITEMS #3 East Valley School District Pedestrian Undercrossing Agreement As part of the Spokane County-Spokane Valley collaboration for Sullivan Road/Wellesley Avenue intersection

improvements and the Bigelow Gulch Corridor project, a pedestrian undercrossing was constructed between East Valley Middle School and East Valley High School to make it safe for students and district personnel crossing Sullivan Road from one campus to the other. An interlocal agreement is necessary in order for the district to have exclusive use of the undercrossing. Staff reviewed the provisions of the agreement and outlined which maintenance responsibilities will be assigned to the City and which to the school district. Council reached consensus to bring a motion consideration at a future meeting for implementation of the interlocal agreement with the East Valley School District.

#4 Balfour Building Potential Options

On March 7, 2023, the Council approved the purchase of the 0.62-acre property and two-story building located at 10303 E Sprague, adjacent to Balfour Park. This acquisition was to integrate the property into park improvements and provide additional parking. Consultants were hired to assess the building upgrades that might be required to bring the facility, which was built in 1968, up to modern standards. Staff outlined the identified building deficiencies and presented four potential options: (1) renovation of the existing structure, (2) construction of a new similar structure with an elevator for accessibility, (3) construction of a new single-story structure, or (4) demolishing the existing structure and installing a grade pad for future development. Estimates of costs were discussed. The Council discussed and reached a consensus to proceed with option four.

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
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



It seems to be getting more like Fall here in the region, and there are some great opportunities for anglers this time of year. Anglers are busy chasing fall Chinook on the Hanford Reach and are gearing up for a better than average return of Coho to the upper Columbia. Our area lakes are offering special opportunities this fall, too.

I wanted to get to Blue and Park lakes before the end of the month to do some perch fishing. I have had some great reports about very good numbers of them being caught and of perch of over 12 inches included in the catches. Since they were going to close at the end of September, I didn't want to get people excited when there would only be a few days left in the season. Well, I just got word that Park, Blue and Deep

lakes seasons have been extended to the end of October, and this change may be permanent. I really like this change and wondered why they closed so early. Nearby Lake Lenore and Dry Falls Lake stay open until the end of November.

I have fished Blue Lake and Park Lake in the past and had a great time catching perch and there are some very nice smallmouth bass in both Blue and Park Lake. When I fished for perch, I was usually at the bottom end of both lakes. I would cruise around slowly, watching my fish finder for a school. When I spotted a good bunch on the screen, I would toss out a marker and then go back to it and put my bow mount electric on Anchor Mode. If the fishing slowed, I would retrieve my marker and repeat the process. I know a lot of people have success experimenting with different jigs and lures. I seem to do okay with just a chunk of nightcrawler.

Fishing for Kokanee on Deep Lake can also be good in the fall. You may have to sort through planted rainbow to get them, and they aren't huge, but they are plentiful. I catch a mix of rainbow and Kokanee with my tried-and-true Kokabow Tackle blades and spinners. So, if you aren't fishing for salmon these lakes offer very good options.

The popular Quincy Valley Chamber of Commerce Pike Minnow Derby is back and is going to be held on October 4th through the 6th this year. If you haven't participated before better sign

up this year. There's over \$35,000 in cash and prizes up for grabs for anglers who turn in their catches of pike minnows at the Crescent Bar Derby Headquarters. Cash prizes will be awarded to those who catch the most fish and the largest and smallest in length caught in both Adult and Youth categories. The grand prize this year is a Polaris Ranger SP 570 side by side! You can register online by logging on QuincyValley. org or at the Crescent Bar Riverbend Park on Friday and Saturday mornings. You can also find tickets at The Quincy Chamber office, Quincy Hardware and Lumber and at Hooked on Toys in Wenatchee. Anglers can turn in catches from the Columbia River from Rock Island Dam to Wanapum Dam. Once again derby participants are treated to



a free lunch at Tower Pizza where the awards are handed out. Don't miss the chance to win money and some amazing prizes at the Quincy Chamber Pike Minnow Derby October 4th through the 6th this year. This week's photo shows boats fishing in the channel near the marina at Crescent Bar.

It's that time of year again. The CCA Tri-Cities Chapter is hosting another Angler Broodstock Collection (ABC) event on October 25-26. It's an amazing experience - catching dozens of salmon per boat each day with the added bonus of knowing that the fish you catch are benefitting the future of fisheries for thousands of anglers. This is a great way for recreational anglers to help promote and support hatchery production on the Columbia River. These wild broodstock are essential to meet the Hatchery Genetic Management Plan requirements for an integrated hatchery so that the hatchery may continue releasing millions of chinook salmon. Thanks to the efforts of CCA, Grant County PUD and WDFW, nearly every one of the 7+ million salmon raised in the hatchery in the past decade have at least one wild parent. The CCA Tri-Cities Chapter has been spearheading the ABC program since 2012. For the past 12 years the project has been operated as a derby called the King of the Reach. I have participated in this event a couple of times over the years, and the Tri-Cities Chapter does a great job.





THE COMMITTEE



Brokers sometimes lovingly refer to multiple clients as "The Committee", which could include members of an LLC or family trust or even just more than two sellers or buyers who all have a say in a sale or purchase of real estate. That moniker always indicates there is more work involved in the transaction. Not just more signatures to obtain (possibly from different parts of the country), but there may also be significant social work involved, like marriage counseling and mediation (in the case of divorce) and maybe even negotiation among the multiple vested partners on the same side of a transaction who don't necessarily agree to terms of a sale or purchase.

Another form of "The Committee" is when mom and dad or other family members tag along for showings and insist on interjecting their strong opinions and intentionally exert influence in the buying process.

Sometimes elderly sellers or buyers rely heavily on adult children or others for guidance since they are marginally physically reliant or maybe even unsteady or unsure of their mental ability to make important decisions about selling the family home or finding a replacement. Brokers are particularly careful in these types of scenarios to be sure the principle players are competent and capable of making wise decisions.

One thing committee members really need to understand is, while brokers are sensitive to family influences and opinions, they are bound by statutes to take orders only from the vested principles in any transaction.

Brokers are careful to pay attention to legal vesting status, whether it's a seller or buyer. That means they can't/ don't take orders from people who are not on title to the property or people who won't be on title after a purchase is complete, unless that person has a legal right (Power of attorney, POA) to participate as "Attorney in Fact" for an individual in that real estate transaction. Brokers are also careful to deal with all (the full committee) vested owners who show up on a title report.

In a recent transaction the actual vested seller was surprised and offended when a committee of concerned church members insisted on influencing a selling process, or even stopping it, by contacting the listing broker.

Brokers often suffer anxiety when non-vested people call and attempt to interject themselves into a transaction or decision making process, especially when the real vested sellers or buyers are not on the same page as the pseudo committee member.

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
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THE FALL CLASSIC RIDES ONCE AGAIN AT TRI CITY RACEWAY Six racing classes, 125 cars to run in 2024 finale

West Richland, Wash. - That the 37th annual Fall Classic even reached this stage of life is remarkable in itself, once one considers recent history.

It has survived the closure of the original home at Yakima Speedway and had 33 editions at the historic track. Yakima Speedway was sold and demolished in 2021 to become an industrial site along Interstate-82 in the city.

The final Fall Classic held at Yakima in 2020 came in the throes of COVID-19. The race was brazenly presented by promoter Doug Beterall – with grandstands full of fans — in the face of legal action from the state of Washington.

And when possibly all was uncertain for the race's future, out of decades of dust arose Tri City Raceway in 2021 and the safety net dropped at just the right time.

Closed since 2004, a group led by Greg Walden worked out a deal with the city of West Richland to reopen the track. Walden operates Hermiston Raceway in Oregon and it was Walden's dad, Wayne who operated TCR from the early 1980s for several decades.

The Tri City Raceway track is part of what is known as the Red Mountain Event Center which is envisioned to be a multi-faceted tourism engine for the city - and theTri City area as a whole.

Now the fourth rendition of the race held on the Tri City half-mile tri-oval some 125 cars in six classes will chase titles at this historic season-ending event for Pacific Northwest racing.

Racing will take place Oct. 4-6 with most eyes on the Northwest Super Late Model Series finale where a 2024 champion will be crowned and the winner earning \$10,000 after 200 laps. Past purses for all classes have surpassed \$100,000 and the event has sold out each year it has been run

since the move.

Besides the NWSLM Super Lates, the race classes include Pro Late Models, Hobby Stocks, Vintage Modifieds, Modifieds and Mini-Stocks.

While not fully certain, Kasey Kleyn from Quincy, Wash. is the odds-on favorite to hang onto the lead he's amassed over a season in which Kleyn has won four series feature races.

Series officials suggest that based on the field size and how Kleyn runs that he essentially has to just start the race.

The 2024 field of super late models includes four former Fall Classic champions, Evan Goetz (2023), Jason Jefferson (2016), BJ Tidrick (2006) and Naima Lang (2011, 2012, 2020). Lang and Cameron Haley (2013, 2014) were the last to successfully defend a Fall Classic championship.

The Fall Classic has a winner's list comprised of the who's who of the region's best late model drivers with Coquitlam, British Columbia's Pete Harding (4), Wenatchee's Garrett Evans (3), Tacoma's Ron Eaton (3) and Lang from Snohomish (3) being notable multi-time winners.
