NOXIOUS WEEDS

What is a Noxious Weed? They are non-native plants that have been introduced to Spokane County through human actions. Because of their aggressive growth and lack of natural enemies, these species can be destructive, competitive, and difficult to control.



CANADA THISTLE

CANADA THISTLE
(CIRSIIUM ARVENSE)

Perennial that grows up to 5ft tall. Slender stems branch near the top. Leaves are prickly spine tipped with a wavy surface. Sharp spines on the branches and main stem. Lavender flowers form in clusters at the end of the stem. Bracts under the flowerhead may have a spiny tip. They reproduce by seed, but mostly spreads through its roots. Pulling is not recommended. Repeated tillage (7-28 day intervals) over several years can be effective. Grazing animals are avoided because of the spiny leaves. Spot spraying with weed killer in the bud stage can be effective.

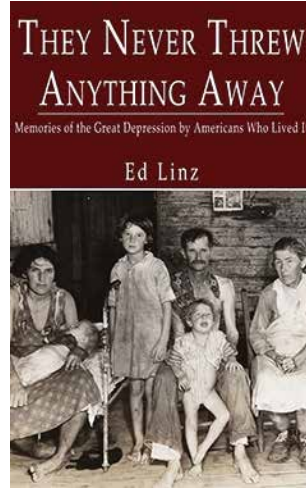

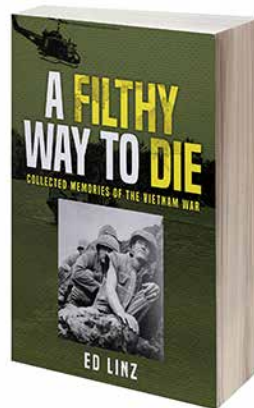

Fishing Magician

While the fall fishery for Chinook salmon has ended on the Hanford Reach, there are many other great fishing opportunities in the region. Steelhead fishing on a certain section of the upper Columbia and the Methow River has opened for the first time in nine years. Perch and crappie fishing is great on Moses Lake, too.

I had a busy day last Saturday. I traveled to Vernita to shoot a video of fishing for fall salmon on the Columbia River, in the Hanford Reach. I started at Priest Rapids Dam, and then drove my truck downstream to talk about the most popular spots to fish for fall kings in this area of the Reach. In a narration style, in order to include as many of the known fishing holes in this stretch of the Columbia as possible. In addition to including descriptions of these spots, all the way down to the B Reactor, I talk about the techniques that anglers use to catch the big kings that return to the Reach. I show the boat launches located just above the Vernita Bridge and mention that there are changes coming to the boating access and camping here. I will keep you updated as these changes come about. The Chinook fishing season in the Hanford is ending, but the best fishing areas that I describe, and the techniques used to catch these big kings will be the same. You will want to refer to this video on the Dave Graybill YouTube channel to make the most of your future fishing trips to the Hanford Reach.

Anglers in the region have something significant to celebrate. A section of the upper Columbia River and the Methow River is going to be opened to fishing for steelhead beginning on October 16th, and until further notice. This gives fans of steelhead fishing the opportunity to catch hatchery steelhead for the first time in many years. Anglers will be able to fish from the Beebe Bridge up to the Highway 173 Bridge at Brewster. The Methow will be open from the mouth to Burma Road. Fishing will also be open to the retention of coho salmon. The daily limit will be two hatchery steelhead or two Coho salmon or one of each. All other salmon and steelhead must be released. The retention of hatchery

steelhead is mandatory. The minimum size is 20 inches for steelhead and 12 inches for coho. Selective gear rules are in effect, except that bait is allowed. A night closure is also in effect. Also, steelhead with an intact adipose fin must be released immediately, unharmed, and cannot be removed from the water. On the Methow, fishing from a floating device is prohibited from one mile upstream from the mouth to four miles upstream from the mouth. Please read the WDFW's news release on this for complete details. See you out there!

Like many other anglers, I am getting my steelhead fishing gear organized. I dug out my bobber and jig rods and will be replacing the leaders and stop knots. I have a whole bunch of jigs



ready, in a variety of sizes and colors. One thing that I have learned over the years is that when it comes to jigs, bigger isn't necessarily better. If you aren't getting bites, go smaller, not larger, even when using bait. Also, I have a couple of very good videos on how to set up for bobber and jig fishing for Steelhead. If you search the Dave Graybill channel on YouTube for "How to Rig for steelhead with a Bobber and Jig", you will find a good one. This video has received over 182,000 views. Another one to watch after this one is called "How to Tie a Bobber and Jig Stop Knot". This has received over 190,000 views and many people have sent me very positive com-

ments thanking me for this one. I have trolled plugs and divers with bait many times with very good success on the Columbia, but casting a bobber and jig is my favorite way to catch steelhead. It works great from the shore or from a boat.

There is good news for anglers that enjoy catching perch. There haven't been that many places where you could consistently catch perch of any size in recent years. I had been trying to get to Park and Blue lakes, where I had heard that the perch were of very good size and in good numbers. However, I found Moses Lake a great place to fish for perch. My friend James Lebow and I gave it a try on Monday, and it was by far the best day of perch fishing we have had in years. We started our day off at the bottom end of Goat Island in 12 to 15 feet of water and were into fish immediately. I was casting a drop shot style set up with a piece of nightcrawler on the hook and caught fish after fish. James tied on an eighth ounce jig head, baited with either a crawler or a perch eye, and was as busy as I was. Most of the perch were eight to ten inches, and we saw a 14 inch perch landed in the boat next to us.

James and I found out that the crappie fishing was amazing, too. He had heard that they were catching them near the I-90 Bridge, and after putting a bunch of fat perch in this live well near Goat Island, we ran up to the bridge. We tied to one of the pilings on the north side of the bridge and put our lines out. There was an angler above us dropping his line into the water from the bridge and hauling in crappie after crappie. He showed us the chartreuse jig he was using, and James found something similar in his tackle box. We moved to the south side, just to be in the sun. The jig worked, and we started catching crappie, too. James said it was the best crappie fishing he had seen since he was a youngster. Most of the crappie are just under the 9 inch size limit but you can still take some keepers home if you stick with it. The crappie are back at Moses Lake! This week's photo is of one of the crappie we caught on Moses Lake.

LARSON DOMINATES NASCAR CUP PLAYOFF RACE AT CHARLOTTE ROVAL | From Racing America

CHARLOTTE, N.C. (Oct. 13) — Kyle Larson didn't need to win Sunday's Bank of America ROVAL 400 to secure himself a spot in the next round of the NASCAR Cup Series Playoffs — he accomplished that before the race's final stage began.

By doing so, though, the Hendrick Motorsports driver collected himself an additional five Playoff Points and further padded his safety net as the eight drivers remaining in the post-season battle it out over the next three races.

His performance was not as dominant as his ass-whooping at Bristol, but the Elk Grove, California-native did lead a race-high 62 of 109 laps, making the final pass for the lead on AJ Allmendinger with 43 laps remaining.

From that point on, it was all about managing the gap for Larson, while also hoping for no late-race restarts, and when none manifested themselves, the Hendrick Motorsports driver cruised to victory.

It's the sixth win of the season for Larson, and the 29th of his NASCAR Cup Series career — six of which have come on road courses.

"It's really the first time in my playoff career that I've not been close to the cutline, so it was good to have a little bit stress-free of a weekend, I think the first time I've been here without crashing — besides the

other time I won," Larson said post-race.

Christopher Bell continued a strong run in the NASCAR Cup Series Playoffs and finished runner-up, 1.511 seconds behind race-winner Kyle Larson. The Joe Gibbs racing driver has only one finish worse than seventh in the post-season.

William Byron brought home a third-place finish, stringing together a sequence of three consecutive top-three results in this round of the NASCAR Cup Series Playoffs.

Austin Cindric entered the weekend in a must-win situation after a heartbreaking loss at Talladega. The Team Penske driver was unable to capture the win, finishing a solid fourth place.

Chase Elliott rounded out the top five, a performance good enough to advance him into the semi-final round of the Playoffs.

DALLAS, Texas (Oct. 13) — Justin Ashley moved into the Top Fuel points lead on Sunday at Texas Motorplex, holding off Clay Millican in the final round and winning in Dallas for the third time in four years at the 39th annual Texas NHRA Fall-Nationals.

Matt Hagan (Funny Car), Jeg Coughlin Jr. (Pro Stock) and Gaige Herrera (Pro Stock Motorcycle) also won the 18th of 20 races during the 2024 NHRA Mission Foods Drag Racing Series season and the fourth of six races in the Countdown to the Championship playoffs.

Ashley went 3.773 seconds at 327.99 mph in his 11,000-horsepower Scag Power Equipment/Toyota dragster in the final round, defeating Millican on a holedshot thanks to a brilliant .026 reaction time on the starting line.

Ashley defeated Antron Brown, Shawn Langdon and Tony Schumacher to reach the final round.

Texas Motorplex continued to bring out the best in defending Funny Car world champion Matt Hagan, who won for the second consecutive year in Dallas for Tony Stewart Racing, defeating Ron Capps with a run of 3.943 at 327.65 in his Garage Dodge//SRT Hellcat.

It is the third victory this season for Hagan and the 52nd in his career as he also moved to third in points, 168 back of leader Austin Prock.

In Pro Stock, Jeg Coughlin Jr. got the better of longtime rival Greg Anderson in the

championship round, picking up his first win at Texas Motorplex in more than 20 years after slipping past Anderson with a run of 6.592 at 208.10 in his Scag Power Equipment car. Coughlin's last win in Dallas came in 2002.

It was another dominant Dallas weekend for Pro Stock Motorcycle points leader Gaige Herrera, who won for the second year at Texas Motorplex after defeating rival Matt Smith in the final round with a run of 6.816 at 200.56 on his RevZilla/Mission Foods/Vance & Hines Suzuki. With the win, Herrera picked up his 20th career victory, reaching that milestone quicker than any driver in NHRA history.

The NHRA Mission Foods Drag Racing Series returns to action Oct. 31-Nov. 3 with the 24th annual Ford Performance NHRA Nationals at The Strip at Las Vegas Motor Speedway.

APPLE CUP REVISITED

The most recent edition of Mahogany and Merlot event in Chelan staged the first week in October, offered hydroplane fans a glimpse of the past with exhibition races between vintage boats like the Miss Bardahl and Miss Thriftway.

According to Hydroplane & Raceboat Museum Executive Director, David Williams, the 1958 Bardahl, driven by Glenn Raymond and the 1955 Thriftway driven by Dane Sorensen both once raced at the Apple Cup but never together.

Unlimited Hydroplanes raced on Lake Chelan in the heart of Washington's famous apple orchard region between 1957 and 1960. The Chelan races were a natural extension of "hydromania" which swept the Pacific Northwest as a result of Stanley S. Sayres' Slo-Mo-Shun IV bringing the sport west in 1950.

Chelan was small-town U.S.A., with a 1957 population of 250, and about 40 miles from a city of any size, decided to go "big-league".

Through the planning of such men as Norm Evans and Jack Lafferty of Chelan, Jerry Bryant of the Seattle Seafair race committee, driver Lou Fageol, and O. Jim Forney, who became the first race chairman, the Lake Chelan Boat Racers, Inc. organization was formed. The Apple Cup races were held in the month of May each year and served as the curtain-raiser each season.

Electrical Safety

Flipping a light switch. Plugging in a coffeemaker. Charging a laptop computer. These are second nature for most of us. Electricity makes our lives easier. However, we need to be cautious and keep safety in mind.



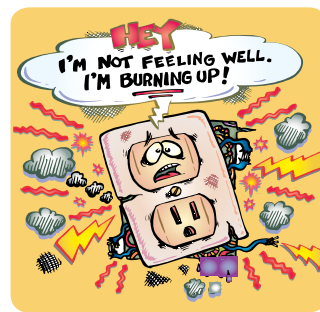
SAFETY TIPS

- Have all electrical work done by a qualified electrician.
- When you are buying or remodeling a home, have it inspected by a qualified private inspector or in accordance with local requirements.
- Only use one heat-producing appliance (such as a coffee maker, toaster, space heater, etc.) plugged into a receptacle outlet at a time.
- Major appliances (refrigerators, dryers, washers, stoves, air conditioners, microwave ovens, etc.) should be plugged directly into a wall receptacle outlet. Extension cords and plug strips should not be used.
- Arc-fault circuit interrupters (AFCIs) shut off electricity when a dangerous condition occurs. Consider having them installed in your home.
- Use ground-fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) to reduce the risk of shock. GFCIs shut off an electrical circuit when it becomes a shock hazard. They should be installed inside the home in bathrooms, kitchens, garages and basements. All outdoor receptacles should be GFCI protected.
- Test AFCIs and GFCIs once a month according to the manufacturer's recommendations. You do not need a flame to start a fire. Fires can start when heat builds up near things that burn. This can happen when a hot light bulb is near things that burn, such as cloth or paper, or a cord has been placed under a carpet.
- Check electrical cords to make sure they are not running across doorways or under carpets. Extension cords are intended for temporary use. Have a qualified electrician add more receptacle outlets so you don't have to use extension cords.
- Use a light bulb with the right number of watts. There should be a sticker that indicates the right number of watts.

IMPORTANT REMINDER

Call a qualified electrician or your landlord if you have:

- Frequent problems with blowing fuses or tripping circuit breakers
- A tingling feeling when you touch an electrical appliance
- Discolored or warm wall outlets
- A burning or rubbery smell coming from an appliance
- Flickering or dimming lights
- Sparks from an outlet

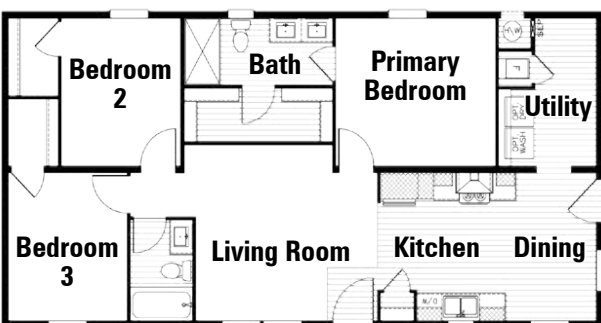
