Darl Wheeler

January 29, 1933 - March 21, 2025

Darl Wheeler lived a long, full life shaped by hard work and a deep commitment to family and community. He wasn't a man of big speeches or dramatic gestures. He believed in showing up, putting in the time, and doing what needed to be done. Over the years, he became a familiar figure in the Spokane Valley and Otis Orchards—dependable, unshakable, and quick with a dry comment or a bit of practical advice.

Born in Rugby, North Dakota in 1933, Darl grew up during the Great Depression, one of ten siblings in a family that made do with very little. In the mid-1930s, the Wheelers moved to Grand Coulee, where everyone pitched in—collecting wool for quilts, helping with sheep, doing whatever work came their way. Eventually, they moved to Spokane, where Darl attended West Valley High School. He worked before and after school, played football, and helped support the family. It was just the way life was.

During his senior year, he met Alice Stevens. They married not long after graduation, and she was by his side over the decades for the rest of her life. Together, they raised six children, ran businesses, and weathered all the ups and downs that came with choosing a life of self-employment and self-reliance.

In 1952, Darl was drafted into the Army. He trained for Korea but was ultimately sent to Germany when the war ended just before his deployment. When he returned home, he met his daughter Patricia for the first time—she was already 18 months old. Shortly after, Darl and Alice moved to St. Maries, Idaho, where he managed a small dairy. But a bigger opportunity came when an 800-acre farm he knew well came up for lease back in the Valley. With little money and no guarantee of success, Darl and Alice took the leap.

They started with cattle and feed, just barely breaking even that first year. But over time, the operation grew—corn, hay, grain, and most notably, potatoes. The whole family helped. Darl worked every part of the business: planting, irrigating, harvesting, washing, packing, and delivering. At the height of it, he was known around town simply as "The Potato King"—a nickname he'd never would have given himself, but one that stuck.

As the years went on, farming got harder. Prices dropped. Costs rose. The well dried up. And when the banker they'd partnered with passed away, his sons gave the Wheelers an ultimatum: buy the land or move. So, they started over—again.

They found 40 acres in the Valley that Darl described, only half-joking, as "a rock pile." But they bought it. They kept growing what they could and opened a small fruit stand on the property. It started as a seasonal operation but turned into something steady, familiar, and appreciated by locals. For a time, they even ran a second stand. Later, when the fruit business slowed, Darl launched a pallet-building/ recycling operation—because there was always work to be done, and he was never one to sit still.

Darl and Alice built their life together on shared labor, loyalty, and devotion to family. They took pride in being able to provide—not just for their kids, but for neighbors, friends, and even strangers who needed a hand. Darl had a habit of extending credit on the honor system, offering second chances, and helping people get back on their feet. He never made a show of it. He just did what he felt was right.

His success wasn't flashy, but it was real. He raised a family that loved and respected him, stayed married through every kind of season, and built a life from the ground up more than once. He wasn't one to dwell on the past, but he carried it with him—lessons learned in the hard years, told through stories, Spokane history, and the kind of advice that came with a little bit of dirt under the nails.

Darl didn't seek recognition. He just wanted to get the job done—and to know the people he cared about were taken care of. In that, he succeeded beyond measure and anyone that knew him is in some way better for it.

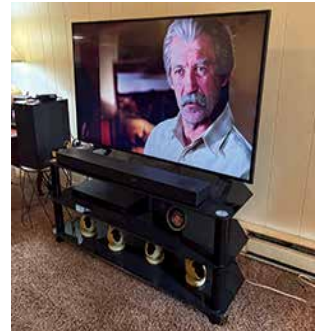

Historic Snow Slide

One of the worst snow slides in the history of northern Idaho occurred early in the morning on March 29, 1894. Within minutes, tons of snow came down the mountain side into a large section of the canyon, just missing most of the town of Black Bear. The canyon was completely blocked. This picture, taken soon after the slide, shows rescuers at work making cuts and tunnels with fifty feet of snow below them. A cut of about 1,000 feet was made along the railroad tracks so the trains could reach Black Bear and the other towns north of the slide. Five people lost their lives in the snow slide.

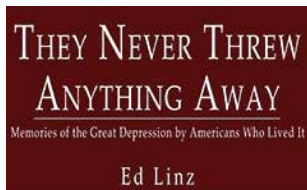

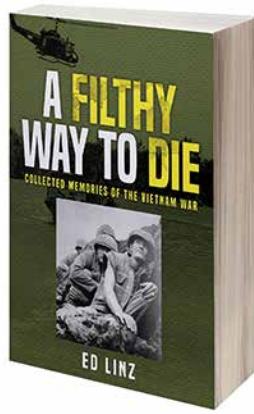

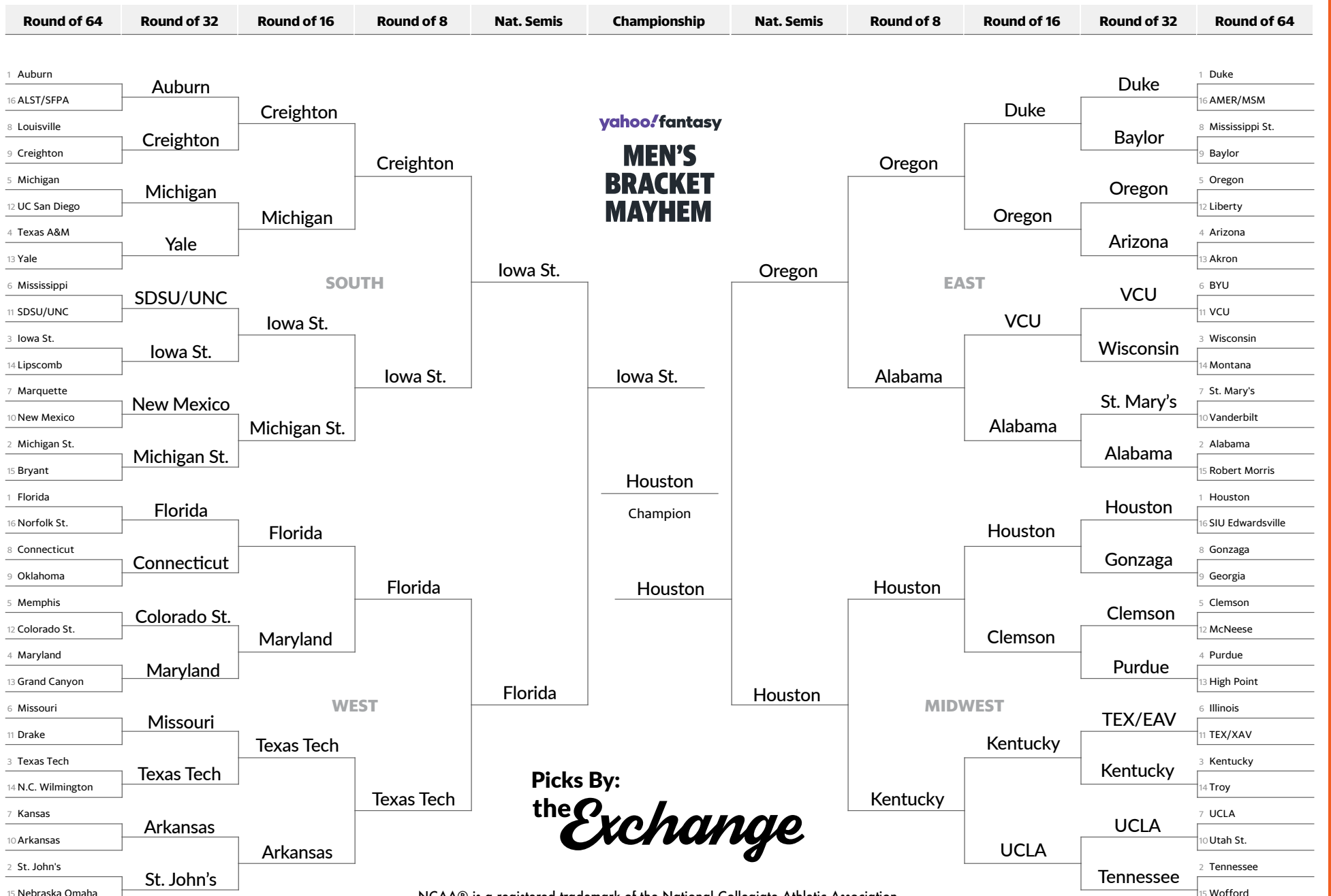

Fishing Magician

"The Outdoor Insider"

The landscape across the region is changing as spring weather melts the ice from the surface of many lakes, and fishing is possible for the first time this season. There are some terrific fisheries available to anglers now, and more coming as water temperatures warm.

I got the word from my contact at the Colville Tribal Hatchery that a large release of triploids was made from the upper net pens last week. I scrambled to get the Smoker Craft ready for its first time on the water this season. I must thank my wife for getting the giant tarp the boat was covered in over the winter. The tarp was oversized but served its purpose. The interior of the boat was bone dry. I was pleased to find everything in working order. The Minn Kota on board charger was doing its job and the batteries for the bow mounted Ulterra were all in the green. My brother in law Tom Verschuren and I met some friends in Coulee Dam on Friday and proceeded to the launch at the middle net pens. The fish had been released from the upper net pens, so we ran up there to start fishing. Although a fish was caught quickly, we weren't seeing the number of fish on the fish finder as we expected. So, we started looking around. The Garmin fish finders were working great as we worked our way along shoreline of the reservoir, looking for fish. When we saw the screen light up with good numbers of fish, I put the bow mount on Spot Lock, and we started casting. We were using eighth ounce jigs of olive or tan color, and even watermelon colored grubs, and they all worked. Fish after fish pounced on these lures and we were cranking in fish at an amazing rate. I was told that the fish that had been released averaged 1.8 pounds and most the fish we caught were in that category. A few were smaller and many were bigger than that. We caught and released until we had our limits of two fish each. What blast! What a great way to start off my boating season for the year. This week's photo is of the Smoker Craft Phantom I am driving for Bob Boats and Motors this season.

I attended the North of Falcon meeting in Wenatchee on Tuesday evening, along with several other interested anglers. This is when the Washington

Department of Fish and Wildlife rolled out the plans for the 2025 salmon and steelhead seasons. I shared a YouTube video of the presentation last week, and this was the opportunity to meet the department staff from the Columbia River manager and our regional people in Regions 1, 2 and 3. The North of Falcon process is months long and although the information presented didn't differ much from what was shown in the YouTube video, there was some new information that wasn't very good to hear. Notably the forecasted number of summer run Chinook that would be available for harvest. The anticipated harvest was just under 700 fish this year, and recent information reduced that number by about 100. It's not good news for fans of fishing



for Chinook. There is always a chance that the numbers could improve, and we will know that in early July. The good news is that we are going to have a great sockeye season again, with a four-fish limit. Right now, a steelhead season is doubtful, but that could change, too.

The sixteenth annual Quincy Chamber of Commerce Trout Derby is almost here. Starting on Friday, March 28th anglers will be gathering at Burke and Quincy lakes in the Quincy Wildlife Area to fish for rainbow trout, with the hopes of winning some of the many prizes that will be awarded. Derby fishing begins at six a.m. on Friday with a mandatory weigh in at four p.m. when fish will have holes punched in their tails to mark them as a Friday catch. On Saturday, derby fishing ends at twelve forty five, and the winners of the adult and youth categories will be announced as soon as all the catches are tabulated. Fishing should be especially good as the Quincy Chamber adds more trout to the lakes just prior to the derby, in-

cluding some whoppers. You can register for the event online by visiting the Quincy Valley Chamber of Commerce website, or at the event. Derby tickets are available at Hooked on Toys in Wenatchee, and Quincy Hardware or the Quincy Chamber office. Don't forget to post a video on the Quincy Chamber Facebook page, and vote for your favorite. I will see you there!

Speaking of walleye, a couple of my friends are getting a few on Moses Lake. They got them below the I-90 Bridge and further up lake in the area known as the Horse Ranch. This is great news for walleye anglers. Moses Lake is often the first of our big reservoirs to warm up and see a walleye bite. The very north end of the lake can provide the fastest action of any walleye water in the state in the spring. Anglers troll side planers with bottom bouncers in three to five feet of water here. Potholes Reservoir continues to be slow, with water temperatures below 40 degrees, and I haven't heard anything about walleye being taken on Banks Lake yet.

There are a lot of changes on the fishing front. Spring weather is coming in stuttering starts and while some lakes have thawed out others are still frozen. Activity has been slowed due to the late spring weather, but things are picking up. To keep my subscribers up to date I am getting ready to distribute the March Update to my E-Letter. I will be sharing what I learn about fisheries throughout the region. There will be maps and photos included in the update and other information not always shared in my regular reports. I plan to talk to some area guides to get some tips on pre-spawn walleye tactics on Potholes, Moses and Banks Lake, and even some videos exclusively on fishing for walleye at some of these destinations. I will also share with subscribers what to expect from Rufus Woods Reservoir this spring. Kokanee fishing on Lake Chelan is always of interest as warmer days encourage anglers to get out on the water. These subjects and others will be covered in the March Update. Go to the FishingMagician.com website to get signed up for the Quarterly E-Letters and Monthly Updates. You won't want to miss a single issue.

Income Tax COUNTDOWN

What could be more satisfying than to have your tax return completely organized, filled out, and signed well before the dreaded April 15 deadline? What feels worse than hunting around for missing records at the last minute, being greeted by an angry glare from a frazzled tax preparer on April 13, or even finding out that you owe more taxes than you expected to pay? You can make things easier on yourself and your accountant by taking these simple steps during the year.



JANUARY-FEBRUARY

1. Start keeping records for the current year's expenses.
2. If tax forms don't arrive in the mail, pick them up at a local bank or post office. Or call the IRS at 1-800-424-FORM.
3. Make an appointment with your accountant or tax preparer.
4. If you are preparing your own return, consult a current-year tax guide.

FEBRUARY-MARCH

1. If you have dependents 2 years old or older who don't have Social Security numbers, fill out Form SS-5 at your local Social Security office.
2. If you were exempt from withholding from wages last year, file a new W-4 form with your employer to continue your exemption this year.
3. If you have not received a W-2 form from your employer or 1099 forms from your bank, broker, and so forth, report the oversight to them.
4. Review your payroll records, check stubs, and receipts; list itemized deductions.
5. List your sources of income, including salary, interest, dividends, capital gains, professional fees, and pensions.

MARCH-APRIL

1. Provide your tax preparer with all necessary records and information.
2. Review completed tax forms for errors and omissions.
3. Sign the forms and write your Social Security number on them. Your spouse should sign a joint return (if filing jointly). Make photocopies for your files and keep them for at least three years.
4. Make out checks or pay amounts due, if any.
5. For a 4-month extension, complete Form 4868. You must still pay what you owe. Make out a check or pay an estimated amount by April 15.
6. Consult your accountant about changes in the tax laws, especially deductions, for them coming year. Adjust your spending, investments, and your files accordingly.

KYLE LARSON GETS FIRST 2025 CUP WIN AT HOMESTEAD-MIAMI

HOMESTEAD, Fla. (March 23, 2025) – Kyle Larson, proved himself the weekend's most dominant driver at Homestead-Miami Speedway winning two of the three national series races, capping off the extraordinary three-day performance with a victory in Sunday's Straight Talk Wireless 400 NASCAR Cup Series race.

Larson was able to seize upon a miscue by his Hendrick Motorsports teammate, Alex Bowman, who put his pole-winning No. 48 Chevrolet in the outside retaining wall with six laps remaining. That contact allowed Larson's No. 5 Hendrick Motorsports Chevrolet to pass him for the race lead and jet off to a 1.205-second win – the 32-year-old Californian's first series trophy of the year.

"I knew me coming towards those guys they were going to start moving around and making mistakes and I felt like if I could just keep pressure on Alex [Bowman], he may make a mistake and he caught the wall there and I got around him easier than I expected to," the 2021 NASCAR Cup Series champion Larson said.

Bowman, who started from pole position, led 43 laps and was obviously disappointed even in a second-place outcome, coming so close to his first victory of the year.

23XI Racing's Bubba Wallace finished third, leading a season high 56 laps in the No. 23 Toyota. Joe Gibbs Racing's Chase Briscoe finished fourth in the No. 19 Toyota – the afternoon proving to be season best finishes for Larson, Bowman, Wallace and Briscoe.

JGR's Denny Hamlin rounded out the top-five finishing order and won Stage 2 – his 15 laps out front are most on the year for him.

Roush Fenway Keselowski Racing's Chris Buescher rallied to a sixth-place finish, followed by Kaulig Racing's A.J. Allmendinger, 23XI Racing's Tyler Reddick, RFK's Ryan Preece and Spire Motorsports' Justin Haley.

With the win Larson moved into second place in the NASCAR Cup Series championship standings, 36 points behind Hendrick teammate, Daytona 500 winner William Byron. Bowman is now third in the championship, 39 points back. The fourth member of the team, Chase Elliott finished 18th and is sixth in the standings

The NASCAR Cup Series returns to action next Sunday at Martinsville (Va.) Speedway for the first short track race of the season, the Cook Out 400 (3 p.m. ET on FS1, MRN and SiriusXM NASCAR Radio). Byron is the defending race winner.

AUTOSPORTS NW SEASON OPENS MARCH 29-30

DEER PARK, Wash. – The old Deer Park Airport was once home to drag racing in the Inland Northwest until Spokane Raceway Park opened in 1974.

The motors still roar, however, with autocross racing that opens in the spring and runs into October under the eyes of Autosports Northwest starting this weekend.

Competition will take place both Saturday, March 29 and Sunday, March 30 starting at 7 a.m. each day.

According to Wikipedia, Autocross is a form of motorsport in which competitors are timed to complete a short course using automobiles on a dirt or grass surface, except where sealed surfaces are used in United States.

Rules vary according to the governing or sanctioning body, such as the length of the course, the amount of permitted attempts, or whether competitors start the course individually at intervals or at the same time as others. In this latter form, Autocross differs from other forms of motor racing by using a system of heats or alternative timing methods for the classification rather than racing for position and declaring the first across the finish line as the winner.

Autocross began in the United Kingdom in the early 1950s at an amateur level within local motor clubs using temporary courses marked on grassy fields to not cause damage to any cars.

"We do use the old road course / drag race strip in Deer Park, which is a decommissioned runway," ASNW Vice President Jason Aguilar wrote in an email.

Each event has a new course design, so competitors have to learn it and drive it in the same day.

"Most courses last about 60 seconds, some less, some more and that will also vary depending on cars, setup, and drivers," Aguilar explained, adding, "Autocross racing has the most driving inputs per minute than any other auto racing."

Autocross offers one of the widest arrays of classes in motorsports, Aguilar said. A typical event will bring in 60 to 80 drivers and can see 100-plus on a rare occasion.

"We have many classes so you can run a stock car up to a fully modified car and anything in between."

Prerequisites are very much limited to take part in Autocross.

"If you have a car and a driver's license, you are able to run with us," Aguilar said. "The skills you will learn will not only help you become a better racer but a better driver in general."

"I personally like to race at the track to keep any street racing temptations at bay," Aguilar said. "This is a very inexpensive way to safely play with your car and push boundaries both personal and automotive, without breaking laws on the street."

LANGDON, LEE, ANDERSON ROLL TO WINS AT NHRA ARIZONA NATIONALS; From NHRA Media

PHOENIX (March 23, 2025) – Top Fuel's Shawn Langdon won for a second straight year at Firebird Motorsports Park on Sunday, powering past Kalitta Motorsports teammate Doug Kalitta in the final round in front of a sellout crowd at the 40th annual NHRA Arizona Nationals.

Paul Lee (Funny Car) and Greg Anderson (Pro Stock) also won the second of 20 races during the 2025 NHRA Mission Foods Drag Racing Series season. It was the second straight sellout this weekend in Phoenix, as fans packed Firebird Motorsports Park.

Langdon put together the quickest run of eliminations in the championship round, going 3.724-seconds at 330.39 mph in his 11,000-horsepower Kalitta Air Careers dragster to get past Kalitta's 3.770 at 325.53. It was the second straight final round for Langdon to open 2025, as he defeated Scott Palmer, Justin Ashley and Brittany Force earlier in the day before picking up his 20th career win and first this season.

He's now made the final round in Phoenix three straight years and enjoyed another stellar weekend at the facility, winning the Mission #2Fast2Tasty Challenge on Saturday and following it up with Sunday's victory, also putting him in the points lead.

"Running [Alan Johnson, crew chief] and Doug in the final, we know what they're capable of, and the run they made in the semi's [3.76], and the one we made only going 3.83, we knew we had to step up, so we kind of threw the kitchen sink at it," Langdon said. (Crew chief) Brian Husen has turned this whole team into a bunch of superstars. All the guys have done such a fantastic job

and have made no mistakes.

In Funny Car, Lee became the 96th different Funny Car winner in NHRA history on Sunday with his first career victory, defeating reigning world champion Austin Prock with a run of 4.030 at 313.22 in his 11,000-horsepower McLeod/FTI Performance Dodge Charger SRT. It was a remarkable performance from Lee, who defeated a slew of standouts to earn his first career win in the category.

"Twenty-one years ago was the last time I won a Wally in Englishtown, N.J., at my home track in Top Alcohol Funny Car and I've dreaming of someday standing here with a nitro Funny Car Wally," Lee said.

In one of the wildest Pro Stock final rounds in recent memory, Greg Anderson picked up his second straight Phoenix win when Dallas Glenn went red in the final round. Anderson, the reigning world champ, barely moved off the starting line as his car had its own trouble, lost power and didn't even make it to half-track.
